Physical Development

Our PE days are on Thursday and Friday and we ask that all children come into school in their PE kits on these days. On a Thursday morning we will be having swimming lessons with Le Mourier and the children have been split into three groups for this, so everyone will have a turn to swim during their year in Reception. If your child is not swimming this term then they will remain in school and do a PE lesson instead. Swimming lessons will run from 21st September to 27th October. Children will need to bring named swimming wear and towel. If they would like to put their costumes on under their clothes in the morning then they can. Our other PE sessions is with Sports Bugs on a Friday afternoon who come in to school and teach the children some fun new skills and games. as possible.

Snack

In Reception the children can have snack whenever they feel hungry. They also have water available to them all day. Please could you bring snack into school in a separate, named container. We also ask that snack includes some fruit or vegetables where possible.
