Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you have had a chance to read about what's happening in your child('s) class this term. I'm really pleased to inform you that the planned activities are fully underway with topic work, Jerrias and French teaching, Padel tennis, Bikeability and Sports Bug sessions as well as trips depending on the year group!

We had a lovely visit from the 2 children who were awarded the 'Spirit of Jersey' trophy in Year Six last year. Health and safety reminders

- No bikes or scooters on the playground

- No use of climbing frames in the main playground or on the newly erected ones in the Early Years' space, the children have plenty of opportunities to use this equipment during the school day
