The children have settled back into routines and expectations of learning so well, it has been great to see their engagement, positivity, and hard work. Each week a child from every class will receive a certificate for an outstanding display of our values-certificates will be taken home the following week - so you may have seen some already!

Updates

We are delighted with all the accomplishments our children have earned during the Eisteddfod competitions so far with Jerriais singing and poetry. Many certificates for gold, silver and bronze were awarded as well as cups for first prize in 2 events! The Education Department French Lead commented in a recent email to me,

We are super proud of all the children and will continue to encourage them to take part in Island wide events. Punctuality and Attendance

As an Island-wide focus, we are working to improve attendance and punctuality figures generally, so please do encourage them to be on time as we have a soft start from 8.30am.
