Mathematics:

The children are still enjoying our drawing club sessions and are already making progress with their writing. Some of the books we will be using this term include, We're going on a Bear Hunt, The Very Hungry Caterpillar and The Koala Who Could.

Phonics:

In phonics this term we will be learning the sounds sh, th, ng, nk, ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air and er. We will also be looking at words ending with double letters and words ending in ing and s. We will continue to learn new sight words and how to put all these new skills together to read and write words and short sentences.

Please continue to read at home and ask your child questions about the story. The children are making good progress and we are really proud of them. Thank you for your continued support.

Personal, Social, Health and Economic:

We will be continuing with our PSHE scheme, Jigsaw. This term we will be covering the topics, Dreams and Goals and Healthy Me.
