

Scavenger Hunts with Colors

Scavenger hunts are a fun way to reinforce simple reading skills, while engaging kids in hands on activities, which you can then extend by categorizing even further, counting items, and/or describing in greater detail what has been found.

Included are Scavenger boards in 6 languages; print out the board with the language that pertains to your classes.

These boards can be used either outside or inside, with multiple uses depending on the location—in the school garden, on the playground, in the classroom, etc, and of course time of year and season. Kids can collect items to match each category, or can draw something they see/find in each box to represent what they have “found”.

I like to give my students a time limit, usually between 5-10 minutes, and instruct them to ‘hunt’ silently so that they don’t give away items to someone else. Once the time is up, gather back together and compare what has been found. You can lump items together and/or make a tally of common items, a great way to debrief afterwards.
