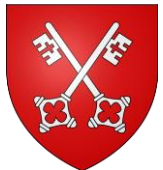


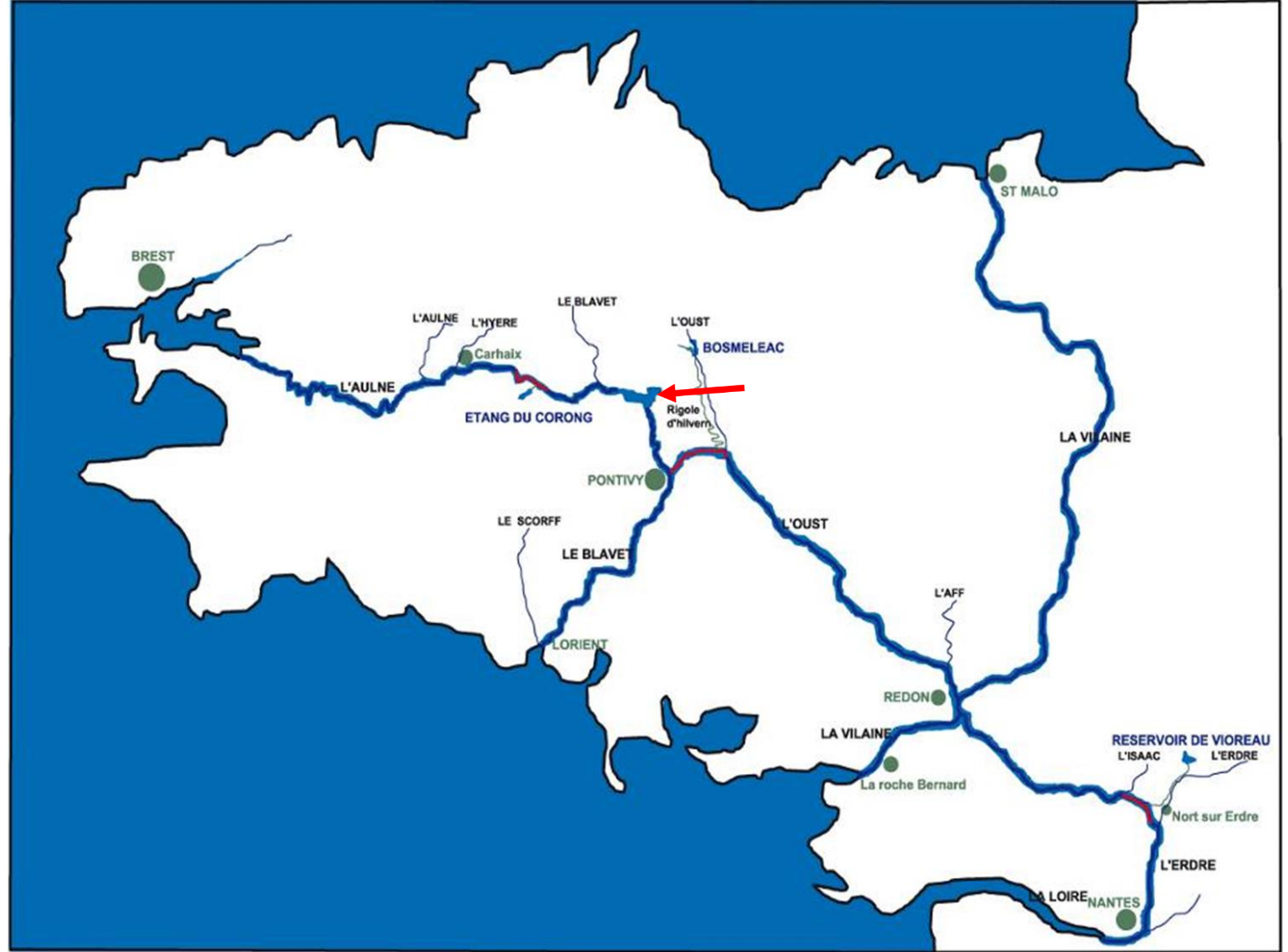


St Peter's School Year 6 French Trip 2026

First Aiders on trip

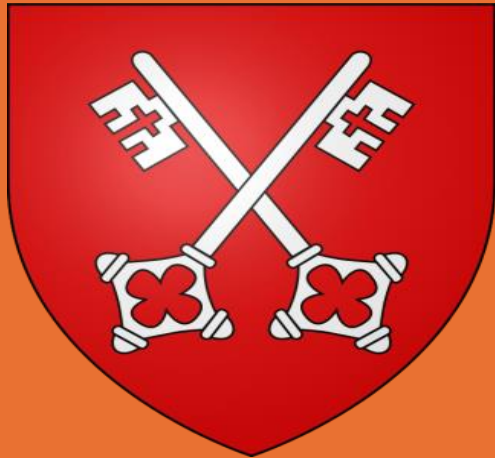
Please talk to us about any medical needs

Preparation

- Communication will be primarily via school, we will check in every day with school
- Pupils will not be able to phone home during the trip but keep an eye on our Facebook page!
- Practise riding a bike over a long distance, off-road (railway walk) and in a woodland route
- Make sure your child's Passport is up to date
- The children need to bring €40 (tbc) for shopping, in a named purse or wallet
- Sleeping overnight – practice if possible
- More details to follow with a final meeting in April/May 2026
- If you/your child starts getting anxious/jittery please come and talk to us...we can answer questions and if necessary and offer support
- And...relax! We will have a ball!

Additional Information

- **Insurance – All pupils undertaking an “off island” trip are automatically covered under the States of Jersey Group Personal Accident and Travel Policy**
- Payment for the trip will be staged. Upon the trip’s return, any trip surplus balances under £10 per student will be retained by the school to contribute towards financial assistance for individual students. Refunds over £10 will be made once the trip accounts have been finalised
- Documentation – All relevant documentation for the trip must be completed and returned to school as soon as possible



Should there be any concerns over behaviour which risk the safety of individuals or the group, we would escort a child home, and parents would meet the cost of this.
