# Groups

# Food and Meals

---

**Fully catered**

---

**Breakfast: cereal, bread, fruit, juice, water**

---

**Lunch: hot lunch (three courses)**

---

**Dinner: hot dinner (three courses)**

---

**We also take biscuits/cakes for daily snacks**

---

**Let us know about any special dietary requirements (food allergies, vegetarians etc)**

---

**Food is home cooked, wholesome, delicious and varied...no frogs-legs or snails!**

# Preparation

---

- **Communication will be primarily via school, we will check in every day with school**
- **Pupils will not be able to phone home during the trip but keep an eye on our Facebook page!**
- **Practise riding a bike over a long distance, off-road (railway walk) and in a woodland route**
- **Make sure your child's Passport is up to date**
- **The children need to bring approx. €40 for shopping, in a named purse or wallet**
- **Sleeping overnight – practice if possible**
- **If you/your child starts getting anxious/jittery please come and talk to us...we can answer questions and if necessary and offer support**
- **And...relax! We will have a ball!**

# Kit List

---

- **Take everything on the kit list (IT IS EXTENSIVE)...the weather can be changeable!**
- **Small/wheeled bag that they can carry independently**
- **Sleeping bags/pillowcase**
- **No electronic games, phones or tablet computers...**
- **Digital camera...and charger/spare batteries**
- **Name everything!**
- **Sun hats, sun cream, waterproof...**
- **Where possible, children should also have a **watch** with which they can tell the time!**
- **No hidden sweets please!**



# Medication

Any medicines which may be required during the week need to be clearly named and labelled with instructions and handed to a member of staff on arrival at the harbour.

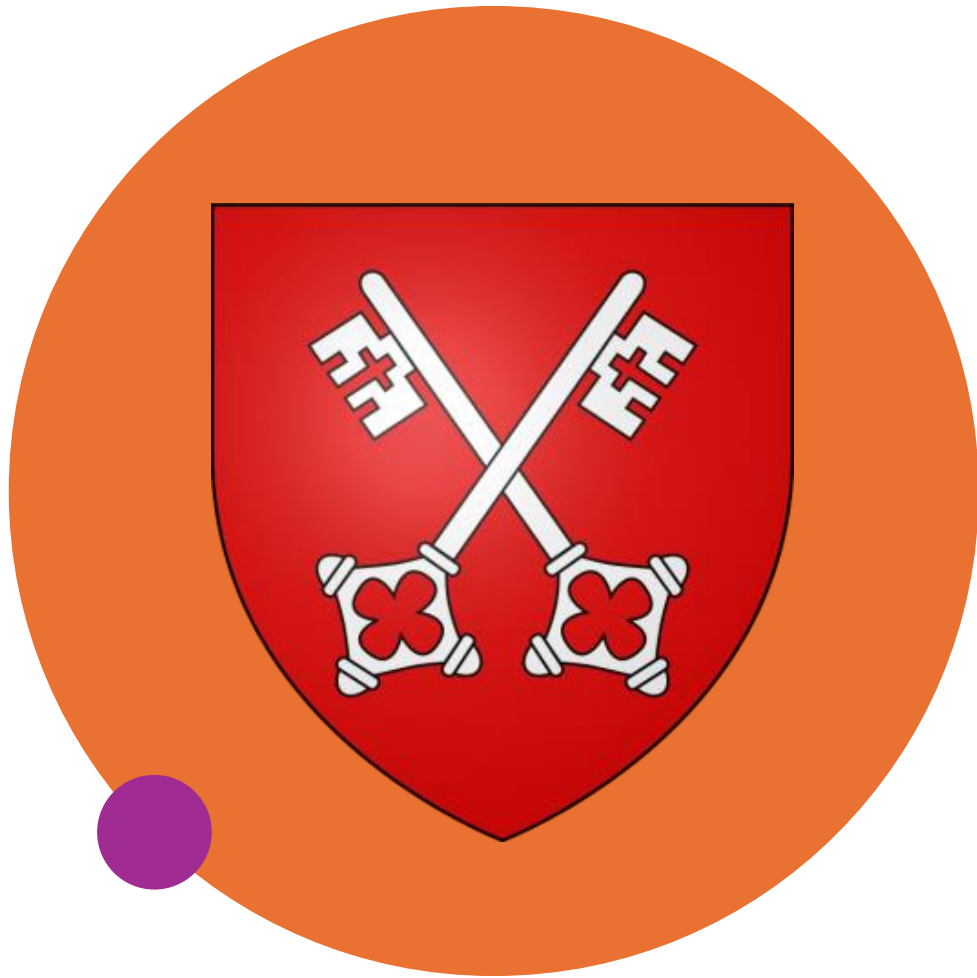
# Safety and Security

---

- **We have sole use of our block or blocks which are locked at night**
- **A teacher is based on each floor**
- **The centre/instructors have all been vetted (DBS equivalent) and hold high-level qualifications**
- **The centre has an excellent safety record (centre in operation for many years)**
- **We have first Aiders on the trip**
- **Sea-sickness tablets are recommended**
- **Please talk to us about any medical needs (children should be up to date with tetanus jab)**
- **All medication needs to come to us in a named bag (we take Calpol/Nurofen/Piriton)**

# Additional Information

- **Insurance – All pupils undertaking an “off island” trip are automatically covered under the States of Jersey Group Personal Accident and Travel Policy**
- Upon the trip’s return, any trip surplus balances under £10 per child will be retained by the school to contribute towards financial assistance for individual children. Refunds over £10 will be made once the trip accounts have been finalised
- Documentation – All relevant documentation for the trip must be completed and returned to school **by Friday 22 May!**



**Should there be any concerns over behaviour which risk the safety of individuals or the group, we would escort a child home, and parents would meet the cost of this.**
