## Suggested Morning Activities and Skills

**Theme: Wizards and Fairy Princesses**



## Afternoon

**Monday**



Listen to the story, 'The Princess and the Wizard' read by Miss Gallichan who will be the Reception teacher at St Peter's School  
Listen to 5 Little Fairies on the Website.

Make a Magic Wand (You will need this later in the week)

- You can make this from whatever you like – we would love to see your creations!

**Independent Activities to complete this week all by themselves!**

**You could make up a box with independent activities in that your child enjoys so they can play by themselves while you do some work.**

- \* Get dressed
- \* Put shoes and socks on really quickly!
- \* Complete a puzzle
- \* Cut out some pictures from cards and magazines
- \* Look for numbers/letters around the environment
- \* Look at a book
- \* Retell a story with puppets
- \* Have a picnic with your teddies
- \* Make a model from your construction toys
- \* Make up a story with small world toys

**Tuesday**



Dress the Wizard or Fairy Princess Cut Out

- Use a piece of card to cut out the body shape of a Wizard or Fairy Princess (see photos)
- How many different outfits can you find inside and outside?



**Wednesday**

Magic Wand Letter Hunt

- Get your wand to help you find letters around your environment. You could dress up too!
- Look for different letters inside and outside.
- Ask a grown up to write some letters and hide them. Use your magic to find them. Can you tell your grown up the letter you have found?
- You could have a go at writing some letters and hiding them for your grown up! They must use the wand!

## Afternoons

Please use the afternoons for exercise and visiting places in our beautiful island. You may be inspired for your, 'Beautiful Jersey,' creative project.

**Thursday**



Ice Castle

- Find some magical bits and bobs (flowers, beads, sequins etc) Put them in water and freeze them.
- You are not limited to ice cube trays you can use loads of different containers or even a rubber glove!
- Can you make an ice castle?



**Friday**



Make a Fairy Princess Garden or a Wizard's Potion

- Make a special Fairy Princess Garden either in your garden or in a flower pot.
- Use a large container outside eg washing up bowl. Can you find some magic ingredients eg flowers, sticks, water to make a potion?
