

Supporting Phonics and Read Write Inc Learning at Home

I know I have given you this email link previously, but I think it is worth sharing it again. This page has a vast amount of resources to support you and your child with their phonics. There are many worksheets to download, if you have access to a printer, and lots of videos that offer advice on how to support your child with blending and reading activities. It also contains links to the live phonic sessions that are on offer and slideshows for sounds and green words are also available.

Support is available for Speed Sound Sets 1, 2 and 3. Scroll down to find the resources that are most appropriate for your child or use them to revisit familiar speed sounds to boost confidence with revision and increase speed and fluency.

I have also uploaded a new sheet of red words. This new list does not strictly follow the RWInc order but is made up of many high frequency sight words that are common in Reception and Year One reading books. The different levels are all on one sheet but don't feel like your child should be able to read them all immediately. Again, start with where your child feels confident and build up. Remember, these are not words to sound out but 'tricky words that we just need to know'. Frequent repetition, little and often is the best way. Make it fun. Chalk the words on the floor to jump on. Hide words on pieces of paper around the house. Spot them in books. Play matching games etc.
