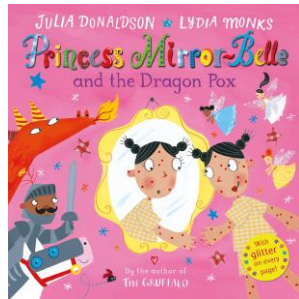




## Early Years: Reception
