We need to know the reason they are unwell and this will avoid us having to call you back to get this information from you.

On Monday, at 1445, we are going to bring Y1-6 out at the same time and line them up, physically distanced in the playground. As we see parents we will call the children to leave the line and come to the gate. We hope that this will make it easier for families waiting for more than one child to collect and go. We will continue to tweak these systems until we get it right and your support is appreciated.
